# **Step 1: Your registration**



# Until January 31<sup>st</sup> / March 1<sup>st</sup>

All visitors and participants of the GOR need to register through our Conftool. This registration is the confirmation that you will attend GOR.

First named authors of the GOR get an allowance on the conference fee. The rebate is not valid for co-authors. Co-authors should register as regular visitors.

### **Registration deadline**

To allow for a mention in the conference program, first authors must register by January 31<sup>st</sup>. The deadline for poster presenters is March 1<sup>st</sup> 2011.

#### **Discounts**

- As a DGOF member you get a discount. Thus, DGOF members pay only 100 EUR.
- The early registration discount for first authors is 180 EUR and is valid for registration until January 31<sup>st</sup> 2011.

Together with your conference registration you can also book attendance of a workshop. Please note that for workshop attendance pre-registration is necessary.

## Your invoice and your GOR 11 ticket – two different PDF files

After your registration through our conference tool you will get your invoice via PDF file. Please pay your conference fee within 11 days (receipt of payment in our account). Your ticket is valid for the conference and – if booked – for the workshops. You will find details about benefits, money transfer and terms and conditions at the registration page.

#### **Refund of fees**

Cancellation of registration for the conference is free of charge until January 31st, 2011. For later cancellations we have to bill the full price.

# Step 2: Check your abstract



# Until February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2011

Please note: The abstract that you have submitted will appear exactly in the same format in the abstracts reader. For this reason we ask you kindly to check your abstract and your personal co-ordinates for the conference print-outs at <a href="http://conftool.gor.de/conftool11/index.php?page=index">http://conftool.gor.de/conftool11/index.php?page=index</a>

<u>Please keep in mind that you are responsible for the accuracy of your abstract in form and content:</u>

Please make sure the following details are correct:

#### **Mandatory:**

- ☑ Author(s): The name format has to comply with conventions mentioned in the Conftool, e.g., Leon Festinger(1), Karl R. Popper(2), James Coleman(1,2).
- ☑ Do not capitalize the entire title. Capitalize the first letter of significant words only, i.e. do not capitalize words such as *and*, *to*, *of*, *in*, etc. as mentioned in the information on your submission.
- ☑ Do not use empty lines or double spaces within your abstract and title, e.g. in the end of our abstract.
- ☑ To begin a new paragraph use only one hit on the RETURN key.
- ☑ Do not provide author name, additional author information in the abstract field.
- ☑ Correct your spelling.
- ☑ Do we have the title of your presentation?
- ☑ The abstract should follow a formal structure and the following keywords should be included in the abstract:
  - (a) Relevance & Research Question
  - (b) Methods & Data
  - (c) Results
  - (d) Added Value

#### **Voluntary:**

- ☑ Did you mention all of your co-authors?
- $\ oxdot$  Do you want to name their affiliation?
- ☑ Do you want to publish their e-mail addresses?
- ☑ Do you like to publish additional contact data of you and your co-authors (URLs, telephone numbers)?

# For Presenters: Step 3: Your Presentation



# Until March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011

#### **Your presentation**

For your oral presentation the usual GOR guidelines apply:

- Length max. 15 minutes plus max. 5 minutes of discussion.
- The slides have to be in English.
- The presentation language is English.

Several presentations will be joined into one **session**. Each session is chaired by a person who facilitates the discussion of the single contributions within this session. The names of the session chairs will be announced shortly before the conference. You will find the number of "your" session when the final program is published. We recommend that you keep in mind or note down your session number. You will find the room number of your session signposted at the conference site.

Please note that program modifications are possible at any time. Make sure to check the slot of your presentation (again) shortly before the conference begins on www.gor.de.

#### **Your slides**

The slides have to be uploaded via our Conftool before the conference. Thus, you will find your file(s) already when you come to Düsseldorf.

Thus, it is necessary to send us your slides in the final version until March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011.

#### **Upload your slides via the Conftool:**

- Name your file(s) as follows: lastname firstname Title of Presentation.
- Use one of the formats: The following file extensions are allowed: pdf, doc, docx, ppt, pps, zip.
- The maximum file size allowed is 11 MB.



## Until March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011

Posters offer a nice opportunity to get in touch with people who share research interests. Use this opportunity to explain your poster! Start a conversation! Posters can be more effective than giving a talk. Please note that program modifications are possible at any time. Please keep yourself up-to-date about the program at <a href="https://www.gor.de">www.gor.de</a>.

#### **Upload your poster**

Your poster has to be uploaded via our Conftool until March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 ("Upload final").

- Name your file(s) as follows: lastname\_firstname\_Title\_of\_Presentation.
- Use one of the formats: The following file extensions are allowed: pdf, doc, docx, ppt, pps, zip.
- The maximum file size allowed is 10MB.

#### The poster format

The poster format has to be DIN A 0 (84.10 cm x 118.90 cm) and has to be upright.
